What is SHU Progress?

SHU Progress provides support for applicants whose personal circumstances might mean that there are barriers for them going to, or considering university

The scheme provides additional support in the year of application and throughout the application process, including the transition to becoming a university student

What support do applicants receive?

- A named contact for advice, queries and to advocate for them
- Referrals to specialist teams and practical support with key stages of the application process
- Exclusive and personal visits to meet staff and current students who can offer advice and support (in person or online)
- Support with travel costs in attending university events or interviews
- Support with making the best application to university including workshops on preparing for interviews
- Regular updates regarding relevant support (financial and pastoral) or opportunities
- Transition - Knowing who and where to go for support once they've enrolled
- Students may be eligible to receive a contextual offer or receive special consideration during the admissions process

How to join



We ask that a professional (such as a teacher, social worker, support worker etc.) who knows the student and their background to fill out the nomination form on our website

Groups supported:

- Care Leavers*
- Estranged students*
- Care experienced*
- Carers*
- Disabled students*
- Experienced circumstances that have disrupted their studies
- Financial difficulties/hardship
- Unable to move away from home area
- Mature students (25+ and returning to learning)
- Homeless/at risk of homelessness
- Refugees/Asylum seekers*
- From a military family
- Military veterans/Service leavers

* We hand over these students to on-course support teams prior to enrolment
