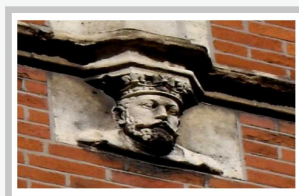

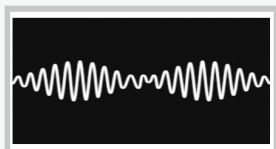

# BONUS
