



Task

Using the materials provided create a newspaper or magazine cover story to celebrate your team and individual successes and achievements over the last 12 months. Use the whiteboard space or flip-chart paper to create your 'year in review' considering how your cover story will look; headlines; images; stories; and quotes.

Purpose

The purpose of this creative exercise is to reflect on your year as a team, visualising and sharing your successes and achievements with the whole directorate.

Duration

50 minutes

Instructions

1. Discuss between the team the highlights of your year, any successes or achievements you have been involved in/with. Feel free to leave the room (go outside / to the deli) to begin your discussions but leave yourselves plenty of time to come back in to the room to put your cover story together.
2. Use the materials provided to create your cover story - use the whiteboard space or the flip-chart paper to put your story together.
3. Make your cover story bold, beautiful and informative.
4. Make sure your team name is on your cover story
5. You do NOT have to feedback to the rest of the room - these are for you to reflect on as a team. We will take photos of each teams' cover story to share on the blog after the event.
6. There will be time during the break to walk the room and see what your fellow colleagues have been involved in.
