Before contacting any proofreaders on the list, please read the following information:

- 1. Make sure you have read and understood all the guidance provided in the Guidelines on third-party proofreading for undergraduate and postgraduate taught students.
- 2. The price per 1000 words quoted below is the minimum price for their services. This is an indicative price to give you an idea what the minimum fee will be. The final fee will depend on the quality of the written work and the time spent proofreading. You will receive a final invoice.
- 3. Feedback from proofreading may include:
 - (A). Proofreading and comments returned electronically with changes tracked
 - (B). Formative report advising the student about areas they need to work on, e.g. grammar, punctuation, frequently misspelt words etc.
 - (C). Meeting with the student
- (A) is provided as standard, but you may be charged extra if you would like to have (B) and (C). Any extra fees would be determined by the time the proofreader spends providing the service. Please note that some proofreaders don't offer (B) and (C)
- 4. You must keep the original of the written work you submit for proofreading.
