



FIELD TRIP TO CHATEAU DU GRAND PERRY, FRANCE

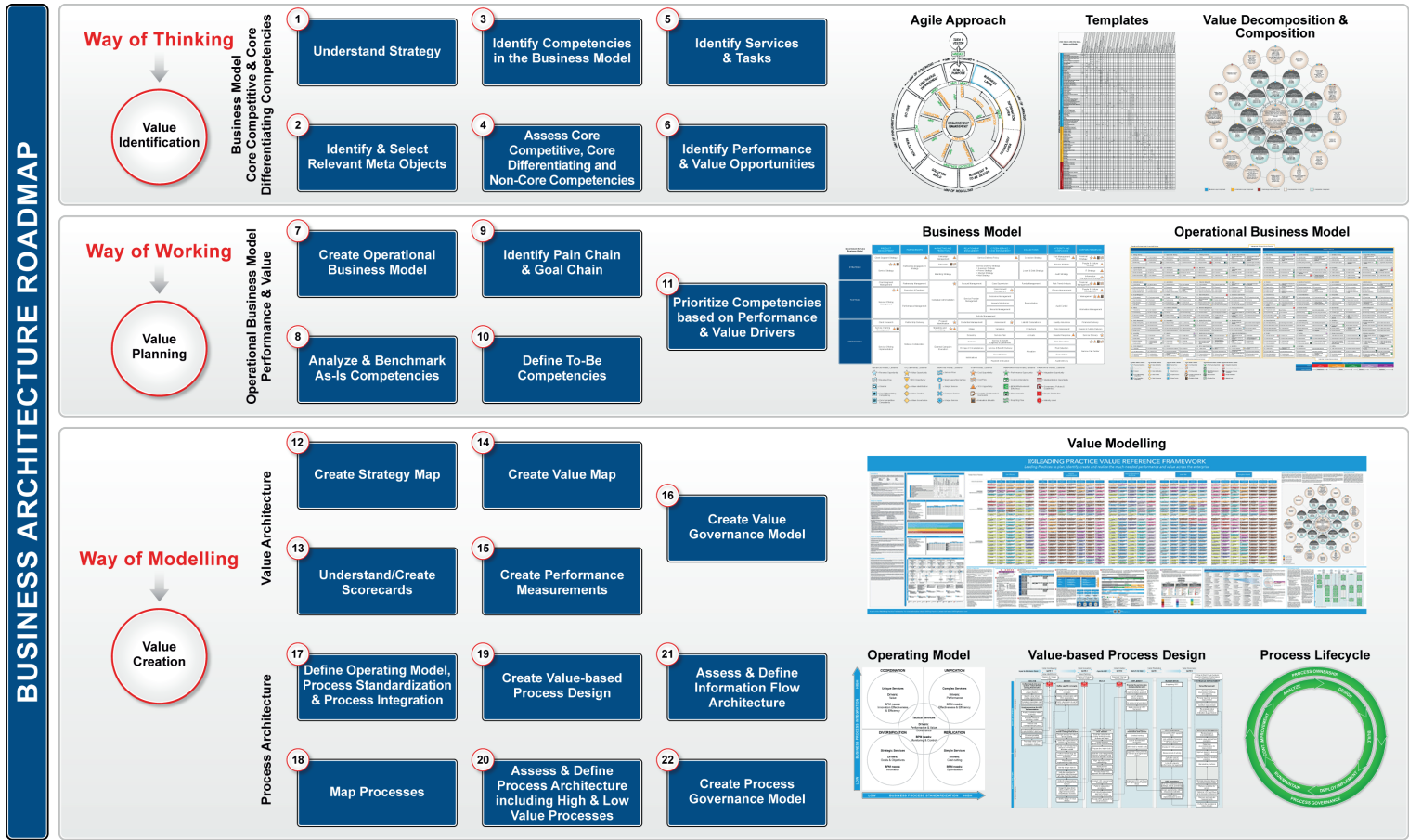
Students will embark upon a one week field trip for the applied **Business Architecture Expert** intensive programme in France from the 15th to 22nd March, 2019. This is an opportunity for students to work on current industrial challenges through an intensive project based setting. Students will spend a block week in France at the Chateau du Grand Perray working on their **Business Architecture Expert** projects immersed in a wonderful setting to facilitate a transformative learning experience.

This opportunity helps us to globalise the curriculum as students will have the opportunity to work with organisations around the globe within and outside the EU. To this end, the applied **Business Architecture Expert** intensive week will develop and enhance employability skills. Furthermore, there is the potential for students to create strong links with employers which may create employment links after they complete their degree.

Students will also get the unique opportunity to engage with top international industry professionals as part of developing their assignment solutions. This is the first applied international intensive delivery within the history of the Computing Department. Students will gain unique global contacts, totally enhance their career prospects and develop a business architecture mindset as a result of this experience. The skill sets associated with this module are the type that can lead to very lucrative careers so this is a fantastic opportunity for final year students.

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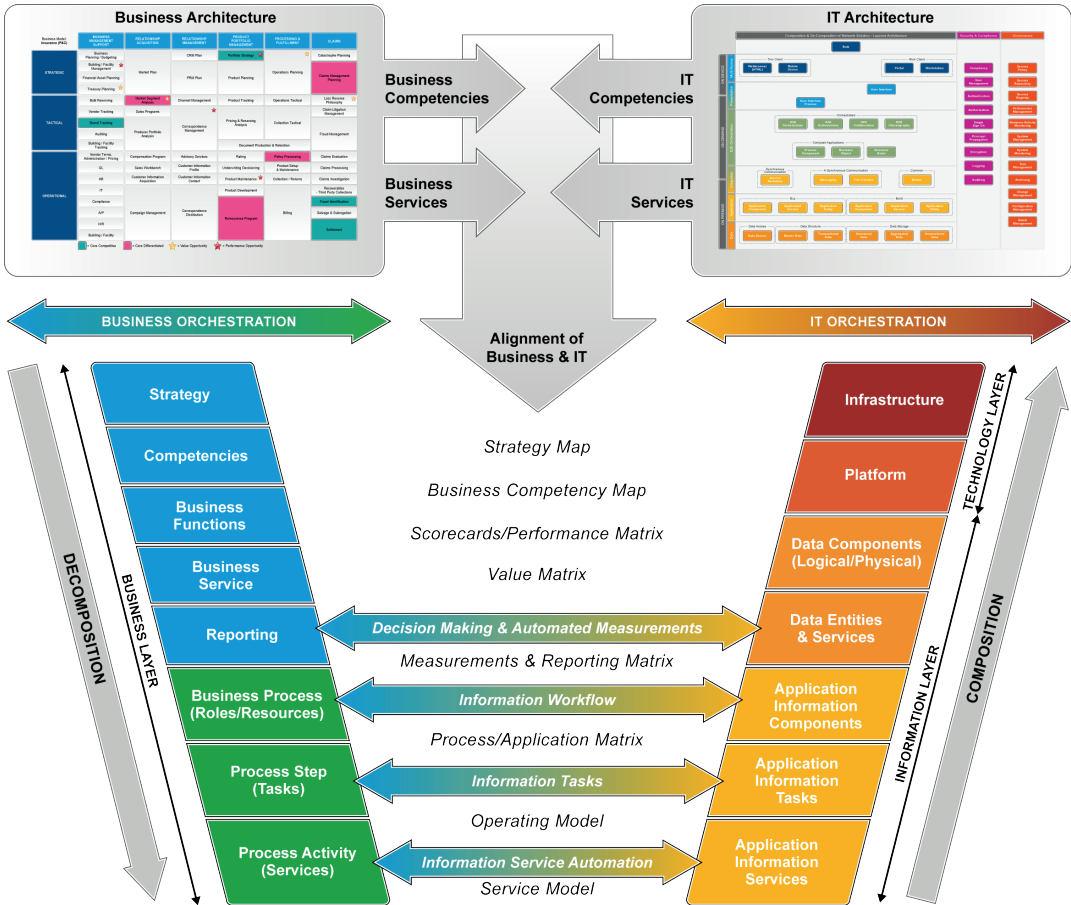
THE BUSINESS ARCHITECTURE EXPERT ROADMAP



The **Business Architecture Expert (BAE)** module encompasses the use of enterprise standards that are applied throughout 52 industries. There is an increasing trend of organisations attempting to architect their business from strategies to the operating model, and to realise transformation and innovation across their organisation.

The applied **Business Architecture Expert** intensive module provides students with the opportunity to work on live industrial case settings. They will apply theory along with industry leading practices to develop artefacts that realise business architecture integration. Industry representation from different sectors will expose students to current industrial challenges and allow them to connect their learning to solve real problems.

LEARNING OUTCOMES



Through this initiative we are able to develop a distinctive curriculum that provides a transformative learning experience. This delivery embodies applied learning as students will be working on applying theory towards real cases to address current industrial challenges.

The Learning Outcomes of the **Business Architecture Expert (BAE)** module will focus on:

- 3) Structure business architecture objects for reuse throughout the business enterprise layers.
- 4) Make use of appropriate software tools to support artefact development.
- 5) Develop artefacts that integrate BA objects to support business transformation.
