BRP collections

Students on Tier 4 visas longer than 6 months, need to collect their Biometric Residence Permit on arrival in the UK. If you have requested for your BRP to be sent to the University, **you can come and collect it between 1–2pm**. Some of you will be collecting your BRP from the Norfolk Street Post Office, if you are unsure of where to go, ask at the Meet and Greet desk.

Opening a bank account

To open a bank account you need your passport and an invitation letter from the University, which you can print off yourself. You can only print it once you have completed the pre-enrolment task. The letter is **only valid when stamped and signed by a member of staff** at the Meet and Greet desk. If you are studying here for less than six months, you may have limited choice when opening an account. Information about banks in Sheffield is available at the Meet and Greet desk.
