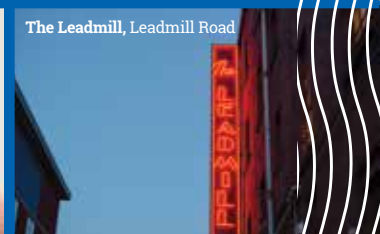

GALLERIES

Soak up some art, Sheffield's got one of the biggest art scenes outside London, and there are countless galleries and studios you can visit for free. But you only really need to walk around City Campus to catch some fine street art on the buildings and walls (see page 42).

BOTANICAL GARDENS

When the sun is out and the sky is blue, the Sheffield Botanical Gardens next to Collegiate Campus are a place to sit back and relax. This is also an excellent study space if you want to get outdoors and enjoy the weather.

MUSEUMS

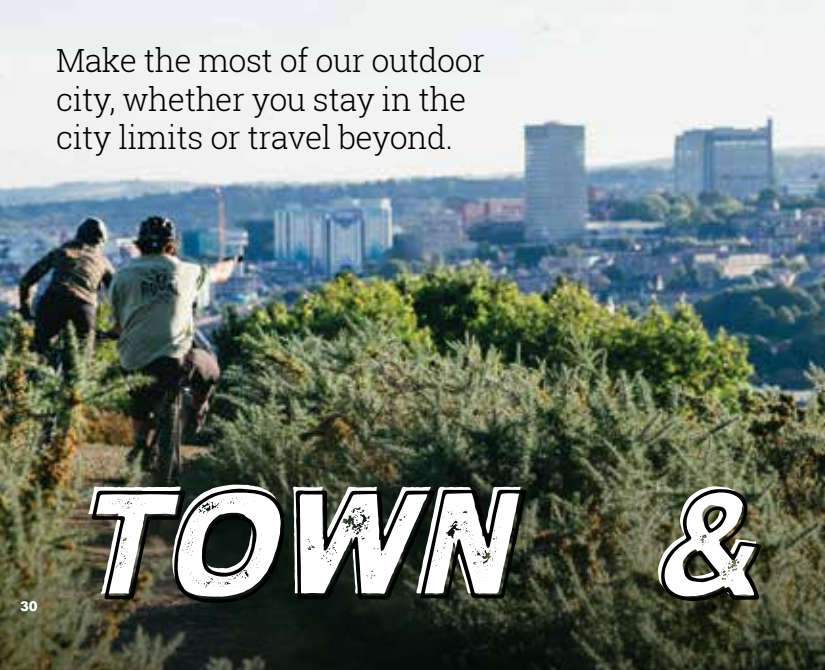
Cinema

HUMPIT Restaurant

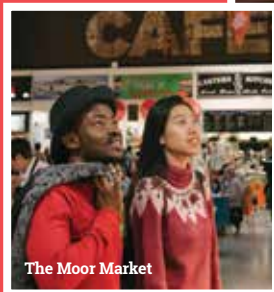

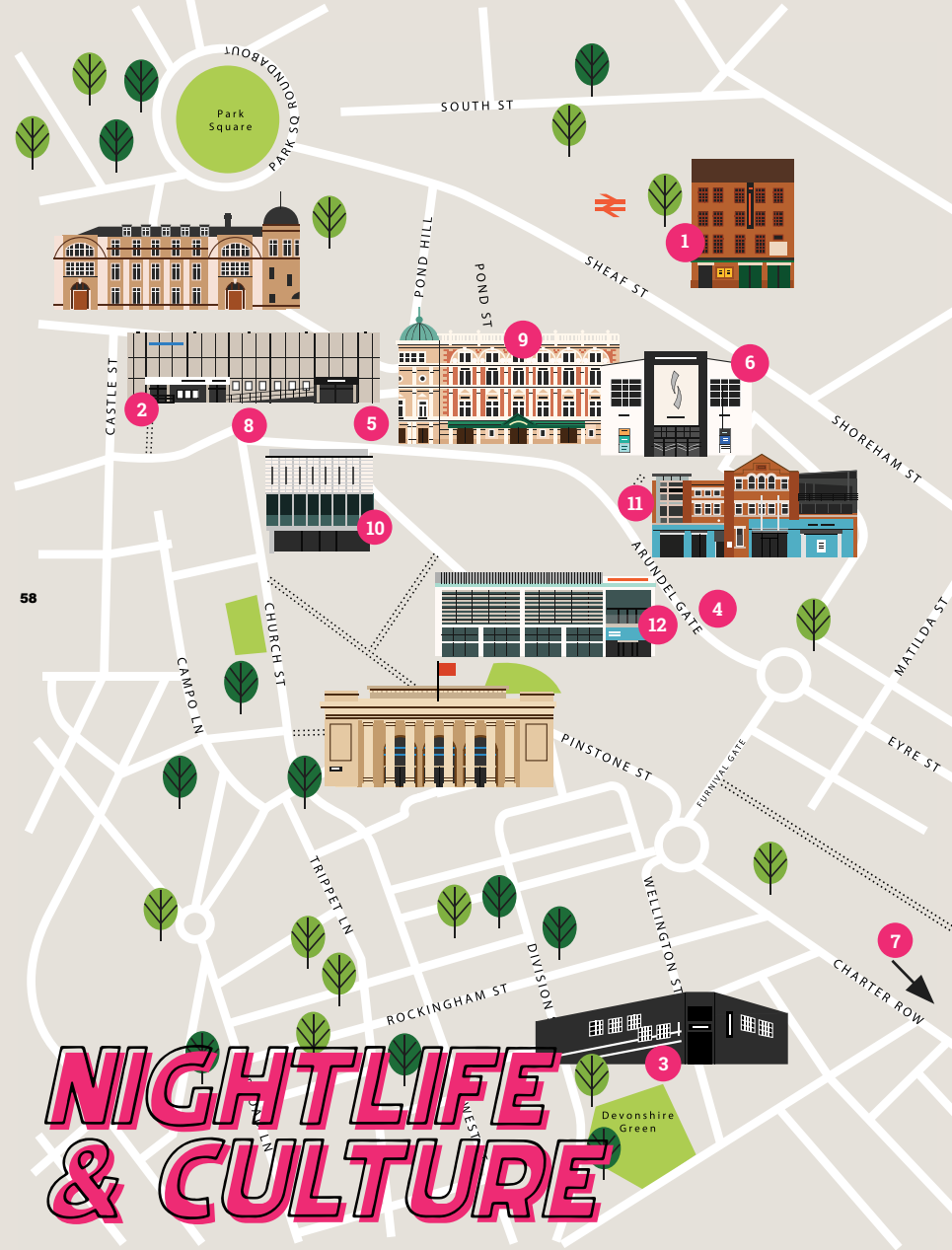

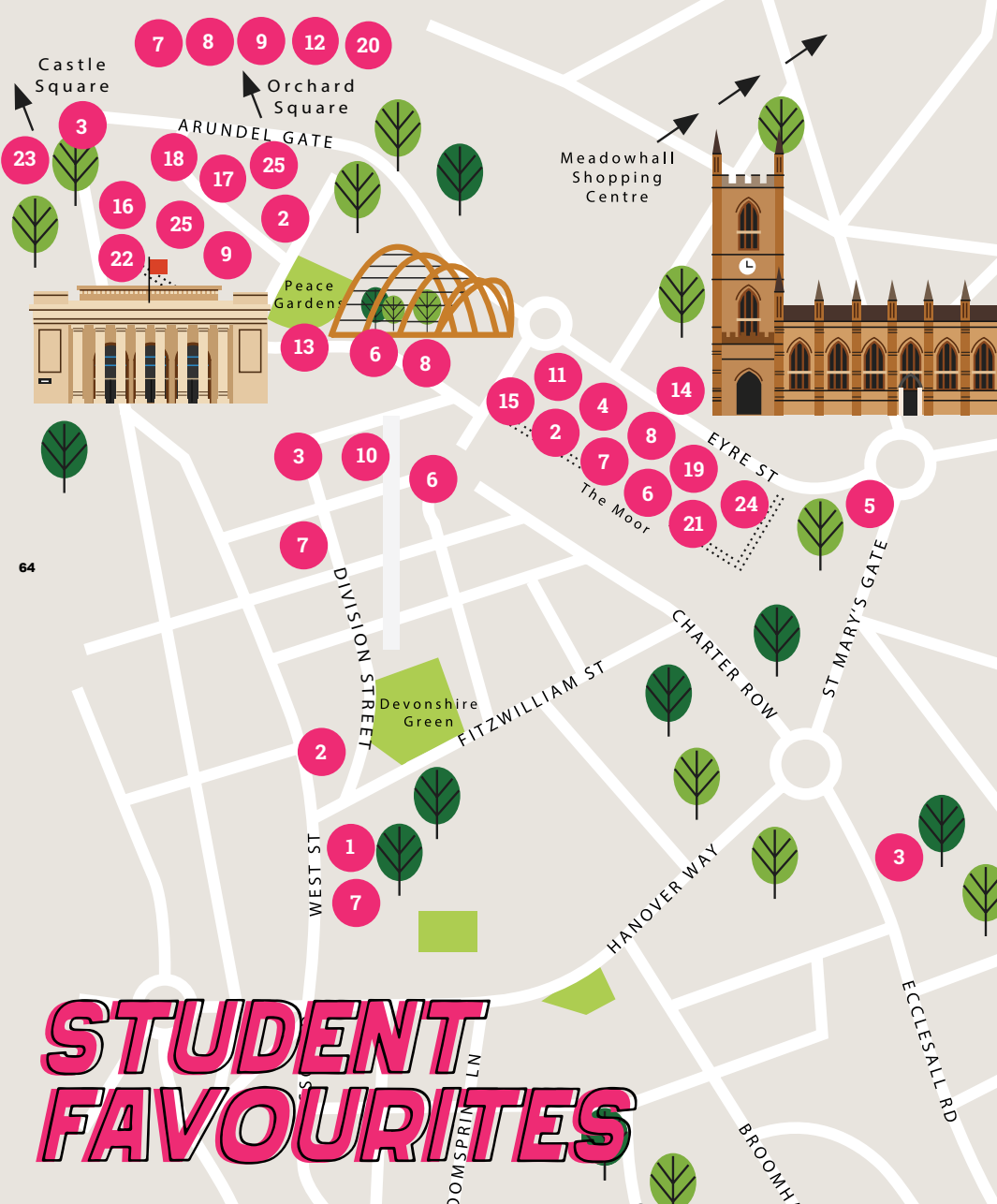
