Important Bursary Information

- Bursary payments can only begin once you are **fully enrolled** and your degree classification has been confirmed.
- Bursary payments are normally made on a monthly basis.
- You will receive a personalised payment schedule when your bursary claim form has been assessed.
- The bursary is not a salary paid in arrears, and is not taxable; however it may be treated as capital income for the purposes of income assessment if you receive state benefits.
- If any of your SKE units are delivered at the same time as your PGCE/Initial Teacher Training course (and you are receiving a teacher education bursary for your PGCE/ITT course), you will not receive the SKE bursary for these units. You cannot receive more than one bursary at any one time.
- Should you withdraw from, or cease to engage with the course, you would be entitled to receive the bursary for the portion of the SKE course you have completed. We would seek to recover any overpayment of bursary from you.
- The training bursary awards are relevant to the academic year of study and can change from year to year.
