Haaga-Helia University of Applied Sciences operates on five campuses in Helsinki, Porvoo and Vierumäki. Three of the campuses are in Helsinki: Haaga, Malmi and Pasila.

Helsinki

The Helsinki Pasila campus is the largest Haaga-Helia campus. Situated right next to the Pasila railway station, the campus offers degrees in International Business, Business Information Technology and Business Service Solutions and Languages.
