## Our campuses

Haaga-Helia University of Applied Sciences operates on five campuses in Helsinki, Porvoo and Vierumäki. Three of the campuses are in Helsinki: Haaga, Malmi and Pasila.

### Helsinki

The Helsinki Pasila campus is the largest Haaga-Helia campus. Situated right next to the Pasila railway station, the campus offers degrees in International Business, Business Information Technology and Business Service Solutions and Languages. Pasila campus also hosts all the Master's degree programmes taught in English. The Helsinki Haaga campus offers degrees in Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management.

### Porvoo

Porvoo is Finland's second oldest city, located about 50 kilometers east of Helsinki. Porvoo is a beautiful small and idyllic city with riverside houses, cobblestone streets and wooden architecture. Haaga-Helia's modern Porvoo campus offers degrees in Bachelor in Hospitality Management and Bachelor in Business Administration.

### Vierumäki
