Student Needs & Aspirations - Take account of, and focus on, the individual needs and career aspirations of your students

Develop Independence - Devise learning activities, including assessment and feedback, that progressively build academic skills and confidence

Develop Self-Regulation - Create formal opportunities for students to reflect on the development of their skills, knowledge and attributes

Embed Personal Professional Development and Planning - Embed, support and monitor PPDP through personal academic support and professional advice enabling student transition through university and to the world of work

Develop Career Management Skills - Consistently offer integrated and timetabled career management skills development opportunities

Provide Real World Experience - Include activities which are similar to those required in external environments and provide the opportunity to benefit from work related and work based learning
