She offers advice on the key features an employer looks for in a LinkedIn profile, often before calling in a candidate for an interview. ### Keep updating your profile

Smita has found that employers ask for your LinkedIn URL first, even before you reach an assessment or interview stage, and so her advice is to make sure your profile is always up-to-date.
