Portfolio review

- For creative courses like Art + Design and Architecture
- Useful guidance is sent out when you get asked to submit a portfolio

- Education interviews we can put you in touch with an academic in the department to answer questions you have

Responding to your offers

You will need to respond to your offers on UCAS by a deadline.

Firm choice

This is your top University/course choice

Insurance choice

- This is your second choice University/course
- It should have a lower offer than your firm choice, but somewhere you'd still be happy to go to
- If your firm choice is an unconditional offer, you don't need an insurance choice

You can't choose between your firm and insurance when you get your results, so make sure you're happy with which is your firm and which is your insurance before you reply.


Dates & Deadlines

31st January 2024 - Equal Consideration Deadline

If you applied by 31st January you will hear back by 16th May

If you receive all decisions by	you must reply by
16 th May	6 th June
17 th July	24 th July

These are based on when UCAS get the last decision in from your unis or colleges. Check your application to see your personal deadline.



UCAS Extra & Clearing

Now: UCAS Extra

- If you've not received any offers or declined all your offers you've received, you might be able to apply for another course through UCAS Extra
- UCAS will notify you if you have <u>'Extra'</u> status
- One application to be considered at one time

Results day: Clearing

 If your results haven't gone quite to plan or you've done better than expected, you can contact universities directly to see if they have any spaces on alternative courses on results day
