- 4. A Course Rep who is equipped with the skills to collect feedback and present it effectively to staff and students.
- 5. A Course Rep who is aware of the Student Charter and feels part of an open dialogue/partnership with members of academic staff
- 6. A Course rep who can see the value and importance to their role and to being a part of the Student Rep system.
- 7. A Course Rep who is able to work with staff and other representatives to foster a sense of community on their course.
